INVITATION

The 2022 Joiners Craft' Award Promoting Excellence in Wood Carving Skill

The Worshipful Company of Joiners and Ceilers will be pleased to receive applications from suitable candidates wishing to participate in the Company's 2022 competition. This prestigious event is open to those who have recently completed, or who are nearing the completion of their training in the craft of joinery or its related activities.

The test will take place on Saturday 21st May 2022 at The Building Crafts College, Kennard Road, Stratford, London, E15 1AH
Competitors will be required to complete a set piece of work under supervision, and between the hours of 8.00am and 5.30pm, with a half hour lunch break from 12.30pm to 1.00pm. The test piece will enable craftsmen to demonstrate their ability to carry out wood carving commissions to good commercial standards, with emphasis on the interpretation of drawings, drawing out of work and the skilled use of hand tools. Materials will be supplied by the Company, but the entrant will provide such hand tools of his or her own, tool can be provided by the college subject to prior notice on your entry form

ENTRY

The Competition is open to:-

1. Candidates, including mature candidates, have recently completed, or are nearing completion of a three-year period of training in wood carving.
2. Candidates who have recently completed, or are about to complete, a two-year full-time training course, or training recognised as of similar standards.

Candidates should complete the ENTRY FORM (obtaining on it the signature of their Employer or College Principal) and either post or E. mail attachment to. Peter Maton at peter@coxformat.co.uk acknowledgment for your entry will be sent within 48 hours. Early submission of Entry Forms would be greatly appreciated but entries must be received not later than 30th April 2022

Applicants will be selected on a first received basis early application is strongly advised to avoid disappointment.

PRIZES

The Winner of the Joiners & Ceilers Carving Award will receive a Certificate, and a prize of £500.00 plus a grant of the Freedom of the Worshipful Company of Joiners & Ceilers.

The second Award will comprise a Certificate and a cheque for £250.00 plus and subject to eligibility an appropriate membership of the Worshipful Company of Joiners and Ceilers.

A certificate and a cheque for £100 will also be awarded to candidates who fail to win the 2020 Joiners & Ceilers Carving First Award or the Second Award, but whose performance in the skill test is judged to be of special merit.

All candidates who participate in the competition will receive a contribution of £25 towards their travel expenses on the day.
